

OPEN UNIVERSITY

SERC is proud to have been approved by the Open University as an appropriate organisation to offer higher education programmes leading to Open University validated awards.

Students can follow an OU-validated Foundation Degree course in Cloud Computing Technologies, in Cyber Security and Digital Forensics, or in Culinary Arts at SERC campuses in Bangor, Downpatrick and Lisburn.

Pending approval, these Open University-validated courses will begin an additional January enrolment from 2023 as well as the September 2023 entry point.

OU-validated top-up degree courses are also available in Cloud Computing Technologies and in Cyber Security and Digital Forensics providing a progression route for those currently studying a level 5 qualification in a related area. These are full-time courses with an option to study part-time.

Pearson BTEC HND in Animal Management

Bangor & Lisburn Duration: 2 Years

The qualifications aim to widen access to higher education and enhance the career prospects of those who undertake them. This course is designed to prepare students for a career in the animal industry or progression to related degree programmes, normally at second year of entry.

BUSINESS & MANAGEMENT

BSc (Hons) Business Management (Validated by Liverpool John Moores University)

Bangor

Duration: 3 Years

As a Business Management student, you will become competent in:

- digital analytical expertise
- managing finance with appropriate tools
- understanding financial markets
- people management development
- marketing of products and services
- planning and project management delivery.

Business simulation tools are used in a number of core modules to replicate real-world work scenarios. Using various applications, students work in small groups and compete to develop the best business strategies for success including business growth, market dominance, ethical business and sustainability goals. Live business projects (with real organisations) allow students to put business theory into practice and help realise genuine business opportunities.



CONSTRUCTION STUDIES

Pearson BTEC HND in Construction Management

Duration: 2 Years

Industry related projects will help develop skills like teamwork, planning, problem solving and communication, all of which you may need in the work place.

HNC/HND courses are well recognised by employers and they will see that you have the technical skills and knowledge to perform related roles within their business.



EARLY YEARS

Code: 10665

Foundation Degree Early Childhood Studies (Validated by Queen's University Belfast)

Lisburn

Duration: 2 Years

There is a huge demand for workers who are qualified at level 5 in the early years sector. The Early Childhood Studies programme focuses on the key theories, concepts and application of working practices with children in the age range 0 to 8 years. On this course you will develop many transferable practical and analytical skills which are valued highly by employers, including the ability to think and reflect critically about your work and the setting you work in. Our Early Childhood Studies Foundation Degree will give you the knowledge and skills that you need to work in a range of roles in the early years sector, including early years settings, primary schools, family support, social work, charities and healthcare settings and will allow for progression to the BA degree. Join us to become a skilled early years practitioner in this dynamic profession.



HOSPITALITY & CATERING

Code: 11051

Foundation Degree in Culinary Arts (Validated by The Open University)

Bangor

Duration: 2 Years

The culinary sector is a dynamic and diverse field that combines creativity, skill, and passion for food, offering numerous career opportunities ranging from cooking and baking to food management and entrepreneurship. An Open University culinary arts degree from SERC offers chefs a high-quality education, exposure to diverse cuisines, and invaluable hands-on experience.

MANUFACTURING & GENERAL ENGINEERING

Code: 10706

Foundation Degree in Mechatronic Engineering (Validated by Ulster University)

Lisburn

Duration: 2 Years

Studying Mechatronics at Level 5 offers a broad and versatile foundation in engineering principles, making it an excellent choice for those looking to enter the engineering field or advance their careers. This program provides a comprehensive understanding of various engineering disciplines, with a slant towards manufacturing automation. It equips students with practical skills and theoretical knowledge that are highly valued by employers and opening up diverse career opportunities. Additionally, it serves as a stepping stone for further education, such as progressing to a Level 6 Bachelor's Degree in engineering.

MOTOR SPORT

Code: 11091

Foundation Degree in Motorsport Engineering (Validated by The Open University)

Bangor

Duration: 2 Years

On completion of the course it is envisaged that students will have acquired a high level of motorsport engineering skills and relevant industrial exposure to allow them to gain employment within the motorsport sector. The course allows you to develop an understanding of the relationship between key areas of motorsport technologies including engine technologies, chassis design, emerging technologies and sustainability issues. You will also develop skills to effectively plan, present and manage motorsport projects.







MUSIC

This course will provide you with a stimulating and challenging programme of study that will be both engaging and memorable, delivering the essential subject knowledge that you will need to progress successfully into further study or the world of work. You will undertake a substantial core of learning in the Higher National Certificate in year one, and can build on this in the Higher National Diploma, in year two with optional units linked to your specialist area of study. Content is continually refreshed so that it is closely aligned with professional body, employer and higher education needs. We provide a varied approach to assessment that supports progression and different learning styles. We deliver a qualification designed to meet the needs and expectations of students aspiring to work in an international music environment.



PERFORMING ARTS

Code: 10626

Pearson BTEC HND in Performing Arts

Bangor

Duration: 2 Years

This course will provide you with a stimulating and challenging programme of study that will be both engaging and memorable, delivering the essential subject knowledge that you will need to progress successfully into further study or the world of work. You will undertake a substantial core of learning in the Higher National Certificate in year one, and can build on this in the Higher National Diploma in year two with optional units linked to your specialist area of study. We provide a varied approach to assessment that supports progression, accommodating and enhancing different learning styles. SPORT & RECREATION

Code: 10708

Foundation Degree in Sport, Coaching and Fitness (Validated by Ulster University)

Bangor & Lisburn Duration: 2 Years

The Foundation Degree in Sport, Coaching and Fitness provides learners with an opportunity to develop a diverse range of related skills through a breadth of core sporting modules. The course is a balance of theoretical and practical aspects allowing for the underpinning of established knowledge in an environment that promotes understanding in application.

WHAT YOU NEED

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Entry requirements for SERC courses vary depending on the course you are applying for. SERC accept a variety of qualifications and use the UCAS Tariff.

Generally you will need to have A level equivalent qualification from your home country in order to secure you admission in HND, University Foundation Degree and Undergraduate programmes. Please contact the international office for specific qualifications needed for a course.



INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION PROCESS

All applications for September entry must be submitted by end of May each year. Once an offer has been made, applicants will have a further 28 days to pay a deposit for the course. Failure to do so, may result in your offer being cancelled.



QUALIFICATIONS EXPLAINED

At SERC we offer a large variety of Higher Education courses which are fully recognised by employers and universities. There are several different pathways and progression routes which allow for further study or employment.

DEGREE

(Level 6)

This is a Higher Education qualification that helps you develop a true understanding of a subject. The qualification is designed to help you develop your analytical and writing skills, while developing technical skills for the world of employment. At SERC we offer both full-time and part-time degree options. We also offer a top-up degree option in specialist subject areas.



FOUNDATION DEGREE

(Level 5)

This is a Higher Education qualification that combines academic study with work-based learning. Designed jointly by universities, colleges and employers, foundation degrees are available in a range of subjects. They are designed to equip you for a particular area of work, as well as giving you the skills that are useful in any type of job. Following a foundation degree, you can progress to a relevant SERC top-up degree or university to achieve a degree qualification. Foundation degrees provide a clear progression route to a bachelor's degree programme, or into employment.

HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMA, HND


(Level 5)

A Higher National Diploma (HND) is a vocational qualification that provides students with practical skills and theoretical knowledge for a specific career. This is usually studied full-time over two years. You will complete an HNC in year one of the course. An HND can lead on to a degree programme or directly into employment.

HIGHER NATIONAL CERTIFICATE, HNC

(Level 4)

A Higher National Certificate (HNC) is a vocational qualification that prepares students for the workforce with practical skills and theoretical knowledge. HNCs are Level 4 qualifications and are usually completed in one year full-time or two years part-time. If you are already in employment, a part-time HNC develops the technical skills which you can put into practice in your current job. Higher National qualifications are highly valued by employers and can also count towards membership of professional bodies and other employer organisations. They focus on learning by doing, and give skills that you can use in a particular job as well as providing opportunities for progression.


